



USRC Trial Scoresheet

Instructions

Original Signatures Required

The form sent to the USRC Administrator of Records requires an original signature of the Trial Secretary and Trial Judge.

After the Trial

At the end of the trial once the judge has completed the scorebooks, the Trial Secretary should copy scorebook information to the scoresheets and make additional 4 copies. The judge should verify that the scoresheets and scorebooks are identical before signing the scoresheets. Only the Trial Secretary and Trial Judge should complete all paperwork.

The original and one copy should be mailed to the Administrator of Records along with the entry surcharges and scorebook bonds (if required). Two copies of the scoresheets should be provided to the judge for his/her records and one copy should be kept by the host club for their records. Forms that are not filled out correctly will be returned to the club for correction and possible fines allocated.

Trial Conclusion Requirements

USRC rules stipulate that within 21 days of the trial conclusion the following must be sent to the Administrator of Records:

- All completed, signed original scoresheets and one copy of signed scoresheets
- A copy of the signed Event Authorization Form
- A check from the host club payable to the USRC for the entry surcharge.
- A complete listing of all trial results to include the name of the dog, the owner, breeder and breed of dog in electronic format. *(Trial results should also be submitted in electronic format to the USRC Web committee and USRC Magazine Editor)*

Failure to submit all required paperwork and fees within the stated timeframe will result in a \$100 fine. Violations in rules or paperwork may result in censure and demotion of club standing.

BH/WH Scoresheet – Instructions

- Use one sheet for each applicable title
- Enter the name of the host club
- Enter the date of the trial
- Enter the location of the trial by city and state
- Enter the name of the Trial Judge and licensing body (USA, ADRK, etc)
- Enter the Judge's judge number
- Enter the name and address of the Trial Secretary
- **Trial Judge fills in the number of entries, passing, non-passing, etc section
- Enter the breed of each entry using the guidelines indicated at the bottom of scoresheet
- Enter the registered name of the dog; it's scorebook number and type (USRC, DVG, etc); it's registration number; current Schutzhund degrees (if any).
- Enter the name and address of the handler for each entry
- Note whether the dog passed the temperament test or not.
- Note whether the dog passed the degree trialed for or not (write 'passed' or 'failed').
- Trial Secretary must sign the original scoresheet prior to making copies.
- Trial Judge must verify information and sign original scoresheet prior to making copies.

SchH/TR/OB/FH/AD Scoresheet – Instructions

- Use one sheet for each applicable title
- Enter the name of the host club
- Enter the date of the trial
- Enter the location of the trial by city and state
- Enter the name of the Trial Judge and licensing body (USA, ADRK, etc)
- Enter the Judge's judge number
- Enter the name and address of the Trial Secretary
- **Trial Judge fills in the number of entries, passing, non-passing, etc section
- Enter the breed of each entry using the guidelines indicated at the bottom of scoresheet
- Enter the registered name of the dog; it's scorebook number and type (USRC, DVG, etc); it's registration number; current Schutzhund degrees (if any).
- Enter the name and address of the handler for each entry
- Note whether the dog passed the temperament test or not.
- Copying from the completed scorebook enter the scores and ratings for each phase (A=tracking; B=obedience; C=protection)
- Copying from the completed scorebook enter the TSB rating, total points and overall rating (V, SG, G, etc).
- Copying from the completed scorebook indicate reason an entry did not complete a trial or if they were excused and why.
- Trial Secretary must sign the original scoresheet prior to making copies.
- Trial Judge must verify information and sign original scoresheet prior to making copies.

After completing all entry information for each degree if there are blank empty spaces write END OF DEGREE ENTRIES in the first empty field.
